

ORDINANCE NO. 1191 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WATER RATES FOR THE PURCHASE OF WATER WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND FOR AREAS SERVED OUTSIDE THE CITY OF OBERLIN

WHEREAS, the existing water rates schedules are deemed insufficient to meet annual operating costs and to comply with the Mortgage Revenue Bond Issue of the City of Oberlin concerning its water plant and distribution system; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase said rates in order to provide the necessary monies for the general program operation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the water rates of the City of Oberlin, shall be as follows:

\$1.00 per hundred cubic feet for all water consumed.
Minimum charge per quarter shall be \$6.00

These rates shall apply within the City Limits of the City of Oberlin


SECTION 2. All retail water users of the City of Oberlin water supply, being served directly now, or in the future directly, outside the City Limits of Oberlin shall pay 50 percent more than the foregoing rates, and the minimum quarterly billing shall be 50 percent more than those rates established within the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
