

ORDINANCE NO. 1197 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A WESTERVELT HALL PRESERVATION COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Oberlin College in a Board of Trustees action passed on April 7, 1973, offered Westervelt Hall to the City for public or combination public-commercial purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin accepted this offer in Ordinance No. 939 AC CMS passed April 23, 1973, and

WHEREAS, the deed transfer for the Westervelt Hall property has occurred and the property now belongs to the City of Oberlin.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin a majority of those elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City of Oberlin herewith establishes a committee to review the range of alternatives relating to the possible uses of Westervelt Hall.

SECTION 2. That said committee shall be called the Westervelt Hall Preservation Committee and shall have a // year period in which to complete its task. three //


SECTION 3. That the members of the Westervelt Preservation Committee shall be appointed by City Council and shall number no more than seven.

SECTION 4. That the Westervelt Preservation Committee shall have available to it the support and assistance of the City Administration and City Council.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
