

ORDINANCE NO. 1200 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING CERTAIN STREET LIGHTS
LOCATED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY FROM OBERLIN MUNI-
CIPAL LIGHT AND POWER RATES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following East and West College Street Alley
lights be exempted from paying current Oberlin electric and power rates:

I. West College Street Alley

Lights Immediately Behind:

Columbia Gas Company	42 S. Main St.
The Tap House	30 S. Main St.
Hallauer Radio & TV	20 S. Main St.
Powers & Dawley	17 W. College St.
The Town Shop	29 W. College St.

II. East College Street Alley

Lights Immediately Behind:


Seeley's Army/Navy Store	29 S. Main St.
Sperry-Gorske Agency	21 S. Main St.
Oberlin Savings Bank	Main & College St.

SECTION 2. That all street lights located in Willard Court be
exempted from payment of current Oberlin electric and power rates.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest
date allowed by law.
