

ORDINANCE NO. 1232 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1349.01 OFF-STREET PARKING AND LOADING OF THE OBERLIN CODIFIED ORDINANCES

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 1349.01 (a) reading as follows:

"1349.01 COMPLIANCE REQUIRED FOR ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND CERTIFICATES. (a) From and after the effective date of this chapter (Ordinance 620 AC, passed April 14, 1969), the following off-street parking and loading requirements are hereby required in the City for all new buildings and for enlargement of existing buildings in order to accommodate the occupants, visitors, customers, clientele and employees of the user of such building or buildings",

is amended to read as follows:


"SECTION 1. - 1349.01 COMPLIANCE REQUIRED FOR ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND CERTIFICATES. (a) From and after the effective date of this chapter (Ordinance 620 AC, passed April 14, 1969) the following off-street parking and loading requirements are hereby required in the City for all new buildings, *change of use of existing buildings* and for enlargement of existing buildings in order to accommodate the occupants, visitors, customers, clientele and employees of the user of such building or buildings."

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
