AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 961 AC CMS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

Effective from and after the first payroll in January 1977,

SECTION 1. / Ordinance No. 961 AC CMS is hereby amended to read as follows:


SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in effect at the earliest date allowed by law.


