ORDINANCE NO. 1283 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF 69 KV LINE IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of the Collier Construction Company of Cleveland, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for the construction of 69 KV line in the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being as follows:

69 KV Line.....\$184,949

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to guarantee the continued and uninterrupted electric service",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
