ORDINANCE NO. 1286 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN EQUIPMENT SURPLUS AND NO LONGER SUITABLE OR NECESSARY FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following equipment belonging to the City of Oberlin is hereby declared surplus equipment and no longer suitable or necessary for any municipal purpose:

- 1. One 1972 Ford Pickup
- 2. One Metal Building Bay
- 3. One ton of copper wire

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To declare certain equipment surplus and no longer suitable or necessary for any municipal purpose,"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
