

ORDINANCE NO. 1287 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR WATER AND SEWER
DEPARTMENT VEHICLES FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN FOR 1977
AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurr-
ing:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Harrison Ford Incorporated of Wellington, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of the trucks for use by the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being as follows:

One New F-350 Ford One-Ton Dump Truck	- \$ 7,040.00
Two New F-250 Ford Utility Trucks	- \$12,153.90

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide vehicles for the water and sewer departments thereby guaranteeing uninterrupted service for the residents of the City,"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
