ORDINANCE NO. 1306 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF OBERLIN UTILITY TAP-IN POLICY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of those members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That paragraph 909.03 (a) (4) of the Codified Ordinances reading as follows:

> "909.03 City Installation of Utility Lines; Connections and Cost Recovery.

(a) . . .

(4) All property owners within the City or hereinafter annexed to the City where these facilities have been installed, shall, within twelve months of the installation or within twelve months of annexation, connect to the sanitary sewer, water line, and/or storm sewer..."

is amended to read as follows:

"909.03 City Installation of Utility Lines; Connections and Cost Recovery.

(a) . . .

(4) All property owners within the City or hereinafter annexed to the City where these facilities have been installed, shall within twelve months of the installation or within twelve months of annexation, connect to the sanitary sewer, water line, and/or storm sewer. In the case at sanitary sewer lines, City Council may extend the twelve month tap-in deadline if a newly annexed property has a Lorain County Health Department approved septic tank. However, when the septic tank ceases to function adequately, a tap-in to the City sanitary sewer line must be made."

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
