ORDINANCE NO. 1308 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE OPEN SPACE REPORT DATED FEBRUARY 1977 AS SUBMITTED BY THE OPEN SPACE COMMISSION OF OBERLIN

WHEREAS, the Plan For Oberlin, identified as a goal for the Open Space and Conservation Commission a strong leadership role in planning for Open Space, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin, by Ordinance in 1970, established as a duty of the Commission the right to advise Council on the implementation of open space plans, and

WHEREAS, the Commission in 1975 and with the assistance of the Lorain County Regional Planning Commission initiated a comprehensive review of needs, conservation and open space in Oberlin and the surrounding area, and

WHEREAS, the review has been completed and a report including goals and recommendations has been presented to City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin,

Lorain County, Ohio, a majority of those members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Open Space Plan as submitted by the Commission is adopted by the Council of the City of Oberlin as a guide in evaluating future development of the community and surrounding area.

SECTION 2. That the City Council directs the City Manager to initiate a process of review, said process to include the Open Space, Planning and Recreation Commissions, in order to advise Council as to what actions should be taken to implement the Open Space Plan.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager, with the appropriate Commissions shall report to City Council by January 1978, the implementation schedule resulting from Section 2 above.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
