

ORDINANCE NO. 1336 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR A DIESEL POWERED
PUMPER TRUCK FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN FIRE DEPARTMENT
AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Arthur Page and Associates of Clinton-
ville, Wisconsin, being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of a
Seagrave diesel powered pumper truck for the use by the City of Oberlin,
Ohio, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby
authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$99,938.00.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit:

"to provide equipment necessary for the continuance
of fire fighting services for the City,"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
