AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF CHARLES M. INK
FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE MORGAN STREET BRIDGE FOR
THE CITY OF OBERLIN, AND AMENDING THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING
APPROPRIATION FOR 1977

SECTION 1. That the bid of Charles M. Ink, of Tiffen, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for the reconstruction of the Morgan Street bridge, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$30,191.00

SECTION 2. That the Federal Revenue Sharing appropriation for the year 1977 is hereby increased by \$4,700.00.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
