

ORDINANCE NO. 1352 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF CHARLES M. INK  
FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE MORGAN STREET BRIDGE FOR  
THE CITY OF OBERLIN, AND AMENDING THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING  
APPROPRIATION FOR 1977

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain  
County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Charles M. Ink, of Tiffin, Ohio, being  
the lowest and best bid for the reconstruction of the Morgan Street bridge,  
be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized  
to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$30,191.00

SECTION 2. That the Federal Revenue Sharing appropriation for  
the year 1977 is hereby increased by \$4,700.00.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest  
date allowed by law.
