ORDINANCE NO. 1367 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR A PICK-UP TRUCK FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN FOR 1978 AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. "to provide equipment necessary for the Municipal Light and Power System," and
