

ORDINANCE NO. 1371 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SOLICITOR TO CONTINUE  
TO PROVIDE LEGAL REPRESENTATION FOR THE CITY IN THE PENDING  
ERIE NUCLEAR PLANT MATTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,  
Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Solicitor be and is hereby authorized and  
directed to continue to provide legal representation for the City's involve-  
ment in the pending Erie Nuclear Plant matter.

SECTION 2. That such representation shall include the contesting of  
the decision of the Secretary of the Ohio Power Siting Commission to pro-  
hibit the City from raising the issue of "wheeling" and to otherwise  
represent the City's interests up to and including the evidentiary hearing  
presently scheduled for July, 1978.

SECTION 3. Such legal representation shall be considered extraordinary  
for compensation purposes.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and  
welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin to-wit:

"To provide for necessary legal services for a pending legal  
matter,"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
