## ORDINANCE NO. 1377 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF STEPHENS AND SON EQUIPMENT COMPANY FOR AN ELBOW UNIT AND BODY AND TRUCK CHASSIS FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of the Stephens and Son Equipment Company of Columbus, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of the Elbow Unit and Body and Truck Chassis for the use by the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$15,629.00.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio; to-wit:

"to guarantee the continued uninterrupted electric service of the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power System,"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
