ORDINANCE NO. 1378 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR THE CLEAN-UP OF THE WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT LAGOON FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Hanover Associates, Inc., of Loudonville, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for the clean-up of the Waste Water Treatment Plant lagoon for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$40,000.

SECTION 2. That there is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Replacement Fund the amount of \$40,000 for the cleaning of the Waste Water Treatment Plant lagoon.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
