

ORDINANCE NO. 1401 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE LEASE OF ONE POLICE VEHICLE
FOR THE YEARS 1978-1979

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin, Ohio, is in need of a new police vehicle; and

WHEREAS, advertisements for bids were made.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the lease of one 1979 Pontiac Station Wagon, for the sum of \$262.86 per month for twenty-four months is hereby approved, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Llewellyn Motor Company, for the lease of the same.
