

ORDINANCE NO. 1428 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SENIOR CITIZENS BUS SERVICE
FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

WHEREAS, the law of the State of Ohio allows the City of Oberlin to provide transportation services for its citizens, including the elderly; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin does not presently have the means to supply such service; and

WHEREAS, the Oberlin Community Services Council, a non-profit group, has such means and is willing to provide such services for and on behalf of the city; and

WHEREAS, there is currently no other non-profit organization that can provide such services for the City of Oberlin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Oberlin Community Services Council is hereby authorized to provide transportation services for the elderly citizens of Oberlin on behalf of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 2. That in consideration therefore, the City Manager of the City of Oberlin is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract to pay to the Oberlin Community Services Council during the year 1979 a sum not to exceed \$5,500 for providing such services for the City.

SECTION 3. That said amount shall be paid upon the presentation of proper vouchers and/or receipts to the City Auditor.


SECTION 4. That the above funds are being provided with the understanding that the Oberlin Community Services Council shall not charge fees other than those necessary to defray expenses for such services and shall carry appropriate liability insurance and save harmless the City from any and all losses sustained by the City resulting from the operation of the said transportation service.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
