"The Code Administrator shall be the staff member responsible to the Housing Renewal Commission. He shall also act as staff support on specific matters to the Planning Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals."

Shall be amended to read as follows:

"The Code Administrator shall be the staff member responsible to the Housing Renewal Commission. He shall also act as staff support on specific matters to the Planning Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals, Human Relations Commission, Electric and Plumbing Review Boards."

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
