

ORDINANCE NO. 1447 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE HIRING SHERRY SUTTLES AS
CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has been without a City Manager for several months, and has screened numerous applicants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, State of Ohio, Lorain County, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Sherry Suttles be and is hereby appointed City Manager of the City of Oberlin, effective May 7, 1979.

SECTION 2. The salary of said Sherry Suttles shall be \$29,000 per year, together with the use of the house and lot owned by the City of Oberlin, known as 205 Morgan Street, as well as any other expense allowances provided by the Ordinances of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 3. The salary for the month of May shall be prorated as of the 8th of May, 1979.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio to-wit:

To provide an executive officer
for the City of Oberlin,

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
