

ORDINANCE NO. 1456 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE
PROPOSAL OF McDONALD & COMPANY, DATED MARCH 19, 1979,
FOR UNDERWRITING SERVICES

WHEREAS, the administrative and legislative branches of the City have determined a need exists in the City of Oberlin for expert financial underwriting services on a continuing basis, and

WHEREAS, McDonald & Company has submitted a comprehensive proposal, dated March 19, 1979, for these services that meets the needs that exist in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and directed to accept the proposal of McDonald & Company, to provide financial underwriting services substantially in the form submitted to this Council and attached hereto.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
