

ORDINANCE NO. 1469 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A WATER TOWER FOR THE UTILITIES DEPARTMENT FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Chicago Bridge & Iron, Chicago, Illinois, being the lowest and best bid for the construction of a 500,000 Gallon Elevated Water Tower for the Utilities Department, be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being as follows:


500,000 Gallon Elevated Water Tower: \$401,240.00

SECTION 2. That the acceptance of this bid is contingent upon the bidder complying with applicable Equal Employment Opportunity requirements and the City's successful sale of bonds for financing the Water Tower.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
