## ORDINANCE NO. 1482 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 705, ALARM SYSTEMS OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 705, Alarm Systems, currently reading as follows:

"705.01 INTERFERENCE PROHIBITED

No person shall install, erect, insert, attach, build, create or otherwise use any alarm system which by electronic, radio, automatic or mechanical means on the occurrence of a given event, circumstance or condition transmits a signal or voice communication for reception by either the Fire Department or Police Department on their established telephone lines or radio bands."

be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"705.01 INTERFERENCE PROHIBITED

No person shall install, erect, insert, attach, build, create or otherwise use any alarm system which by electronic, radio, automatic or mechanical means on the occurrence of a given event, circumstance or condition transmits a signal or voice communication for reception by either the Fire Department or Police Department on their established telephone lines or radio bands, without the prior written approval of the Fire Chief or the Chief of Police."

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
