

ORDINANCE NO. 1515 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL REFUSE AND
GARBAGE DISPOSAL CONTRACT FOR THE YEAR 1980 TO BROWNING
FERRIS INDUSTRIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the base bid submitted by Browning-Ferris
Industries of Ohio, Inc., for the disposal of garbage and refuse for the
City of Oberlin, being the lowest and best bid, is hereby accepted and
the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, said
bid being \$16,473.60, *with the condition that BFI meets the affirmative
action ordinance within 30 days.*


SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit:


"To provide for the continuance of State approved
