

ORDINANCE NO. 1542 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH WIEGAND ELECTRIC, INC., OF AMHERST, OHIO FOR MINIMAL REPAIRS TO THE EXISTING WIRING AND CIRCUIT BREAKER SYSTEM AND INSTALLATION OF A NEW GENERATOR AT THE OBERLIN POLICE STATION BUILDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the wiring, circuit breaker system and emergency generator located at the Oberlin Police Station Building are substandard and in need of emergency repair, and

WHEREAS, the present condition of said wiring, circuit breaker system and generator present a real and present emergency arising in connection with operation of the Oberlin Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Wiegand Electric, Inc., of Amherst, Ohio, for a sum not to exceed Six Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$6,300) for minimal repairs to the wiring and circuit breaker system, and for the installation of a new emergency generator at the Oberlin Police Station Building.


SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to insure that adequate electrical power is provided at all times to the Oberlin Police Department",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
