

ORDINANCE NO. 1547 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE, ADOPT AND ENACT THE 1980 REPLACEMENT PAGES TO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES: TO REPEAL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; TO PUBLISH THE ENACTMENT OF NEW MATTER; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, certain provisions within the Codified Ordinances should be amended to conform with current State law as required by the Ohio Constitution; and

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed by Council which should be included in the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Council has heretofore entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company to prepare and publish such revision; and

WHEREAS, the codification of such ordinances, together with the new matter to be adopted, the matters to be amended and those to be repealed are before the Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected there-to concurring:

SECTION 1. That the ordinances of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, of a general and permanent nature, as revised, recodified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes, titles, chapters and sections within the 1980 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances are hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. That the following sections and chapters are hereby added, amended or repealed as respectively indicated in order to comply with current State law:

301.04	Bicycle; Motorized Bicycle. (Amended)
301.19	Motorcycle. (Amended)
301.20	Motor Vehicle. (Amended)
301.27	Public Safety Vehicle. (Amended)
301.51	Vehicle. (Amended)
303.99	Traffic Code Misdemeanor Classifications and Penalties. (Amended)
313.02	Through Streets; Stop and Yield Right-of-Way Signs. (Amended)
331.38	Stopping for School Bus, Discharging Children. (Amended)
333.03	Maximum Speed Limits; Assured Clear Distance Ahead. (Amended)
373.16	Motorized Bicycle Operation, Equipment and License. (Added)
537.14	Domestic Violence. (Added)
537.15	Temporary Protection Order. (Added)
549.05	Unlawful Possession of Dangerous Ordnance. (Repealed)

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety and for the further reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of the 1980 Replacement Pages to the officials and residents of the City, so as to facilitate administration, daily operation and avoid practical and legal entanglements, wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage.
