

ORDINANCE NO. 1552 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING BIDS FOR CHEMICALS USED IN WATER
TREATMENT AND WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANTS OF THE CITY OF
OBERLIN, OHIO, FOR THE YEAR 1981
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following being the lowest and best bids for cer-
tain chemicals used by the Water Treatment Plant for water treatment and by the
Waste Water Treatment Plant for waste water treatment, for the year 1981, are
hereby accepted, and the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract
accordingly:
