

ORDINANCE NO. 1570 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR SURFACE TREATING AND RESURFACING  
VARIOUS STREETS IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS  
DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State  
of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Griffith Blacktop, Inc., 3158 Omaha Avenue,  
Lorain, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for surface treating and resurfacing  
various streets in the City of Oberlin for the Department of Public Works, be and  
the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into  
a contract accordingly, the locations and bid being as follows:
