

ORDINANCE NO. 1589 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1187.03 (c) OF THE
CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO,
SETTING FORTH DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE
HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 1187.03 (c) of the Codified Ordinances of
the City of Oberlin, Ohio, presently reading as follows:

"(c) Duties and Powers.

- (1) To establish basic standards for selection of sites, buildings and structures to be placed in a list of potential historic landmarks.
- (2) To compile and maintain a current list of potential landmarks; the list shall include reasons for historical significance.
- (3) To hold public meetings of occupants and property owners of potential historic buildings and structures.
- (4) To recommend to Council historic structures and buildings for inclusion in a final list."

be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

"(c) Duties and Powers.


- (1) To establish basic standards for selection of sites, buildings and structures to be placed in a list of potential historic landmarks.
- (2) To compile and maintain a current list of potential landmarks; the list shall include reasons for historical significance.
- (3) To hold public meetings of occupants and property owners of potential historic buildings and structures.
- (4) To recommend to Council historic structures and buildings for inclusion in a final list.
- (5) To gather, compile, and maintain materials pertinent to the cultural heritage of the community.
- (6) To disseminate information which will assist residents in identifying and preserving buildings which contribute to the character of the City."


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
