## ORDINANCE NO. 1594 AC CMS

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE OBERLIN BASEBALL FEDERATION TO ERECT A CONCESSION STAND IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN PARK STREET PARK

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Oberlin Baseball Federation is hereby authorized to erect a concession stand in the City of Oberlin Park Street Park, said authorization conditioned upon the Baseball Federation entering into an agreement with the City which includes the following particulars:

- 1. The structure and surrounding landscape comply with any aesthetic recommendations made by the Oberlin Planning Commission, and  $\underline{\text{COVE}}$ .
- 2. The Oberlin Baseball Federation agree to maintain said structure at their sole cost for a period of three (3) years from the effective date of this ordinance.
- 3. The Oberlin Baseball Federation acknowledges that the structure is the property of the City of Oberlin, and the City shall have all authority and control over said stand and any concessions sold therein.
- 4. The Oberlin Baseball Federation agree to hold harmless and indemnify the City from any claims made as a result of injury or damage arising out of the existence or use of said structure by the Oberlin Baseball Federation.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
