ORDINANCE NO. 1599 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING JAMES F. LONG AS INTERIM CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Sherry A. Suttles, has tendered her resignation as City Manager of the City of Oberlin, effective September 30, 1981, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has formally accepted said resignation and desires to appoint an Interim City Manager until such time as Council appoints a new City Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected therero concurring:

SECTION 1. That JAMES F. LONG is hereby appointed Interim City Manager of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, commencing October 1, 1981, in accordance with Section 5 of the Charter of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To immediately provide for a chief executive officer of the City of Oberlin until such time as City Council appoints a new City Manager",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
