

ORDINANCE NO. 1606 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID FOR A PASSENGER CAR  
FOR THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL LIGHT AND POWER SYSTEM

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain  
County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Harrison Ford, Inc., of Wellington, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for supplying a 1981 Ford Fairmont for the Oberlin Municipal Light & Power System, be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being as follows:


1981 Ford Fairmont . . . . . \$6,799.00

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
