

ORDINANCE NO. 1616 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE RESIGNATION OF EUGENE F. SIMON AS TREASURER OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND APPOINTING DALE S. SUGERMAN TREASURER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Eugene F. Simon, has tendered her resignation as Treasurer of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, effective immediately, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin desires to accept said resignation and fill said position at the earliest possible time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected there-  
to concurring:

SECTION 1. That the resignation of Eugene F. Simon as Treasurer of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, is hereby formally acknowledged and accepted.

SECTION 2. That Dale S. Sugerman is hereby appointed Treasurer of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, effective immediately.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide for a Treasurer for the City of Oberlin at the earliest possible time in order to insure the effective management of the City",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
