AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 145.09 (f) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO - STANDBY PAY, WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 145.09 (f) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin, presently reading as follows:

"145.09 GENERAL PAY PROVISIONS.

(f) The Public Works Director shall designate certain personnel to fill one-week shifts as service man on the handling of all Water Distribution trouble calls. One man shall be on call in such capacity at all times from December 1, to April 1 of each year and shall receive eight hours' additional compensation for a completed work shift",

is hereby amended to read as follows:

"145.09 GENERAL PAY PROVISIONS.

(f) The Public Works Director shall designate certain personnel to fill one-week shifts as service man on the handling of all Water Distribution trouble calls. One man shall be on call in such capacity at all times from December 1, to April 1 of each year and shall receive seventeen hours' additional compensation for a completed work shift".

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
