ORDINANCE NO. 1631 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF NOR-CON, INC., OF NORWALK, OHIO FOR LOCAL WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENTS AS PART OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN'S HUD-CDBG PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Nor-Con, Inc., of Norwalk, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for local water main improvements to the Oberlin water distribution system, being part of the City of Oberlin's HUD-CDBG Program, is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, for a sum not to exceed \$131,058.50.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to promote adequate water flow and to correct severe system deficiencies",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
