

ORDINANCE NO. 1633 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN EQUIPMENT SURPLUS AND NO LONGER
SUITABLE OR NECESSARY FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:
