ORDINANCE NO. 1641 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING EAST COLLEGE STREET, WEST COLLEGE STREET, NORTH PROFESSOR STREET AND SOUTH PROFESSOR STREET, WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, TO NOT BE THROUGH STREETS AND ENACTING A 25 MILE PER HOUR PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMIT THEREON

WHEREAS, Section 4511.65 of the Ohio Revised Code and Chapter 305 and 313 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin authorize the City Council of the City of Oberlin to determine which streets within the municipality shall be considered "through streets" and thus subject to a 35 mile per hour prima facie speed limit; and,

WHEREAS, City Council desires to designate certain streets within the municipality to not be through streets and set a lower prima facie speed limit thereon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following streets located within the municipality are hereby designated to not be through streets and shall be subject to a 25 mile per hour prima facie maximum speed limit from and after the effective date of this ordinance:

- a.) <u>College Street</u> from the intersection of West College and West Lorain Street to the intersection of East College and East Lorain Street.
- b.) Professor Street from the intersection of South Professor and West Hamilton Street to the intersection of North Professor and the Oberlin municipal corporation limit.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby directed to erect the appropriate speed limit signs upon said streets and amend the traffic control map and file accordingly.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
