

ORDINANCE 1661 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE
ALL U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS PERMITS NECESSARY FOR
THE PROPOSED DREDGING AND CLEANING OF PLUM CREEK, AND
DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS THEREFORE
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of
Lorain, State of Ohio, 5/7ths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed
to execute all necessary U.S. Army Corps of Engineers permits relevant
to the proposed Plum Creek dredging and cleaning project, and to accept
the terms and conditions thereof on behalf of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed
to advertise for bids for said project as set forth in the plans and
specifications as previously prepared and approved by the U.S. Army
Corps of Engineers.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal
actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this
Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all
deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted
in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance
with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised
Code.


SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency

and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:


"to advertise for bids for said project at the earliest possible
