

ORDINANCE NO. 1695 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO,
FY 82 CDBG PROGRAM PLAN RELATIVE TO THE INSTALLATION AND
REPLACEMENT OF CERTAIN SEWER LINES AND STREET IMPROVEMENTS
WITHIN THE PLAN TARGET AREA AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,
State of Ohio, 5/7ths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the FY 82 CDBG program plan for the City of Oberlin is hereby amended to include certain modifications to proposed installation and replacement of sewer lines and street improvements within the plan target area as set forth in the exhibit attached hereto, subject to the approval of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Ohio Department of Development.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.




"to insure timely construction of proposed CDBG improvements within the plan target area"

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT

FY 82 PROGRAM AMENDMENT

1. The proposed Hamilton Street sewer will be shortened from 1,700 to 800 feet in length.
2. The Smith Street sewer will be altered to include only a small lift station to serve only the three homes at the easterly end of Smith Street.
3. The Spring Street collector sewer will be expanded in length to run from Plum Creek southwesterly through the target area to the intersection of Grafton and Park Streets.
4. The proposed street improvements to Spring Street south of Groveland will be deleted. The resultant savings will be utilized to pay for the expanded Spring Street collector sewer.
