ORDINANCE NO. 1722 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF BURGESS & NIPLE, LIMITED, MENTOR, OHIO, FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE ARTINO STREET UTILITY AND STREET EXTENSION AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT ACCORDINGLY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the proposal of Burgess & Niple, Limited, of Mentor, Ohio, for Engineering Services associated with the Artino Street Utility and Street Extension is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for same, said proposal being dated July 29, 1983, and not to exceed a basic engineering cost of \$12,743.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

" to insure timely completion of Artino Street improvements"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
