

ORDINANCE NO. 1727 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING CERTAIN MONIES DONATED TO THE
CITY OF OBERLIN IN MEMORY OF VEE LONG FOR THE PURPOSE OF
ESTABLISHING A NURSERY IN WESTWOOD CEMETERY

WHEREAS, there has been tendered to the City of Oberlin the sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000) Dollars to establish a memorial and nursery in Westwood Cemetery in memory of Vee Long, and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to formally accept said monies for said purpose and establish a separate fund account for same,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City of Oberlin hereby accepts the sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000) Dollars donated to the City by the family of James F. Long, and others, for the purpose of establishing and maintaining a municipal nursery in Westwood Cemetery in memory of Vee Long.


SECTION 2. That there is hereby established a separate fund account for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to be designated "Vee Long Memorial Fund", for the deposit of said monies, to be used only for the uses and purposes set forth hereinbefore.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
