

ORDINANCE NO. 1738 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HERK EXCAVATING, INC.  
OF VERMILION, OHIO, FOR THE FURNISHING AND PLACEMENT OF ROCK AND STONE  
FILL FOR THE OBERLIN WATER TREATMENT PLANT RESERVOIR  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,  
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Herk Excavating, Inc., of Vermilion, Ohio,  
for the furnishing and placement of approximately 800 tons of Type 601B  
rock and 25 tons of No. 2 crushed stone fill for the Oberlin Water Treatment  
Plant Reservoir, being the lowest and best bid received, is hereby accepted,  
and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a  
contract accordingly, said bid being in the amount of \$13,463.25.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions  
of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance  
were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations  
of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal  
requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency

safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:


"to insure placement of said rock and stone fill prior to the onset
