ORDINANCE NO. 1742 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF THE LORAIN COUNTY VOCATIONAL CENTER TO ADMINISTER THE OBERLIN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT LOCAL JOBS PLACEMENT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the proposal submitted by the Lorain County Vocational Center to administer the Oberlin Community Development Block Grant Local Jobs Placement Program is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said proposal being in an amount not to exceed \$15,433.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to implement the Jobs Placement Program at the earliest possible time" and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
