ORDINANCE NO. 1774 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HARRISON FORD, INC.  
OF WELLINGTON, OHIO, FOR TWO ONE-HALF TON PICKUP TRUCKS FOR  
THE CITY OF OBERLIN MUNICIPAL WATER AND STREET DEPARTMENTS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,  
State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Harrison Ford, Inc., of Wellington, Ohio,  
being the lowest and best bid for supplying two one-half ton Pickup Trucks for  
the Oberlin Municipal Water and Street Departments, be and the same is hereby  
accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a  
contract accordingly, said bid being in the amount of \$18,674.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions  
of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were  
adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this  
Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, in-  
cluding Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date  
allowed by law.
