

ORDINANCE NO. 1778 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A CONTRACT BETWEEN  
THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF RUSSIA TOWNSHIP, OHIO,  
FOR THE FURNISHING OF LIMITED FIRE PROTECTION TO CERTAIN PORTIONS OF  
SAID TOWNSHIP AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,  
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the proposed agreement between the City of Oberlin and the Board of Trustees of Russia Township, Ohio, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, for the furnishing of limited fire protection by the Oberlin Fire Department to certain portions of Russia Township, is hereby authorized and approved, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute same on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to insure uninterrupted fire protection for certain portions of  
Russia Township"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
