ORDINANCE NO. 1783 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH JOSEPH BOYLAN OF ASHLAND, OHIO, FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A GRINDER LIFT STATION FOR THE ARTINO AVENUE EXTENSION PROJECT WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Joseph Boylan of Ashland, Ohio, for the purchase and installation of a Grinder Lift Station for the Artino Avenue Extension Project within the City of Oberlin, Ohio, for an amount not to exceed \$12,890.00.

SECTION 2. That the purchase and installation of said grinder lift station is hereby declared to constitute a real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation and maintenance of the Department of Public Works of the City of Oberlin, pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to attempt to complete construction of the extension of Artino Avenue within the City of Oberlin at the earliest possible date"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
