ORDINANCE NO. 1795 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF NICK LICURSI, INC., OF CLEVELAND, OHIO, FOR LANDSCAPE CONTRACTING SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE OBERLIN DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Nick Licursi, Inc., of Cleveland, Ohio, for the furnishing of landscaping services in connection with the City of Oberlin Downtown Revitalization Project, being the lowest and best bid submitted, excluding certain bid quantities, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, subject to the availability of funds, said bid being in the amount of \$18,891.22.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to proceed with the Oberlin Downtown Revitalization Project at the earliest possible date in order to complete same prior to the onset of inclement weather"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
