

ORDINANCE NO. 85-10 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 143.04 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES  
OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, RELATIVE TO ELIGIBILITY FOR  
APPOINTMENT AS FIRE DRIVER IN THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL FIRE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,  
State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby enacted Section 143.04 of the Codified  
Ordinances of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, reading as follows:

143.04 ELIGIBILITY; FIRE DRIVER.


- (a) Prior to the conclusion of their probationary period,  
all full-time Fire Drivers shall:
  - (1) Reside within a three (3) mile radius of the  
Oberlin Municipal Fire Station; and,
  - (2) Obtain telephone service at their residence  
within the Oberlin local telephone exchange.
- (b) Failure to satisfy said requirements prior to the conclusion  
of the probationary period or failure to thereafter con-  
tinuously abide by same shall be cause for dismissal.


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions  
of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were  
adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this  
Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, in-  
cluding Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date  
allowed by law.
