

ORDINANCE NO. 85-32 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MICHAEL BENZA AND ASSOCIATES, INC., OF RICHFIELD, OHIO, FOR THE FURNISHING OF ENGINEERING SERVICES TO THE CITY OF OBERLIN RELATIVE TO CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS TO EAST AND WEST COLLEGE STREET WITHIN THE CITY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the proposal of Michael Benza and Associates, Inc., of Richfield, Ohio, dated March 19, 1985, for the furnishing of engineering services to the City of Oberlin relative to certain improvements to East and West College Street within the City, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said proposal setting forth payment upon an hourly basis for work performed and not to exceed \$25,944.00, and said monies are hereby so appropriated.


